Our Non-Residential services are provided to survivors of domestic violence and their children who are not in need of shelter but who would like access to counseling, support groups, safety planning and legal referrals. Our Coordinator of Case Management and Legal Advocacy, Taylor Breaux, helps clients with obtaining legal assistance, such as protective orders, and safety planning. Callie Williamson, Coordinator of Counseling and Children Services, and Kendall Pasko, Child Advocate, provide individual counseling for adults and children, and ongoing personal support and advocacy.
